

CONCEPT AND OBJECTIVES

- Sumforest takes over the objectives of the Standing Committee on Agricultural Research (SCAR) Collaborative Working Group (CWG).
- Sumforest establishes a network bringing together 23 key actors from 15 EU member states, 3 associated states and 2 international institutions → harmonizing existing and future research programs; supporting policy decisions


CONCEPT AND OBJECTIVES

- Sumforest: will **deepen the mutual understanding of sustainable forest management and multifunctional forestry**, providing a scientific basis for policy decisions in the framework of the **Europe 2020 Strategy**, and for the **new EU Forestry Strategy**.
 - Developing a comprehensive method for mapping forest research capacities and transnational cooperation.
- 
- Implementation of **strategic joint activities and transnational research funding** (reinforce scientific cooperation, reduce fragmentation and maximise the impact of research activities on sustainable forest management, and multifunctional forestry).

CONCEPT AND OBJECTIVES

- Creation of an European forest research area:
 - Well-coordinated European, national and regional research programmes and priorities,
 - Coordinated research institutions and centres of excellence,
 - Joint research facilities and Pan-European networks of large-scale research infrastructures with long-term funding.
 - Strengthened science-policy-practice interaction (crucial for sound policy-making and for fostering innovation).






