

Virtual Component

This Staff Week will be organized as an **Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Program**. This includes a **virtual component**, where the participants meet online before/after the staff week.

There will be an online session on 07.04.25, focusing on:

- Getting to know each other and the team at FH JOANNEUM
- Input on sustainability
 - Preaching water and drinking wine Why universities must do more to promote sustainability: A 45-minute input session discussing the role of universities as catalysts for a sustainable future, and the challenges and opportunities this presents.

Furthermore, a short quiz on the topic of 'Health and Wellbeing in the workplace' will be sent to the participants in advance. The results will be presented during your stay and incorporated into an Al-supported video.

You will receive further information after the registration deadline.

Travelling to Graz

We encourage the use of green transport wherever possible. Graz is located in Central Europe and is easily accessible by train or bus from many European destinations. Tickets can be booked via OEBB or FlixBus. The FH JOANNEUM is a 10-minute walk/two tram stops from Graz Hauptbahnhof.

Arrival via plane

- To Graz Airport Thalerhof: you can fly directly to Graz and get into the city via train (S-Bahn, line S5 to Graz Hauptbahnhof), bus (line 630 to Jakominiplatz) or taxi. Graz airport is small and does not have many connections, tickets may be expensive.
- To Vienna airport Schwechat: another option is to fly to Vienna and get to Graz via train or bus. You can take the train from Vienna airport to Graz Hauptbahnhof every hour (every second connection requires a change of trains at Vienna Hauptbahnhof), tickets can be booked in advance via OEBB or directly at the station. Another option is to take the FlixBus service from Vienna airport to Graz Girardigasse; direct services approximately every 2 hours. You will need approximately 3 hours to get from Vienna airport to Graz.
